## NAGA Senior National Championship Tournament Information

**GOLF COURSE:** This facility is located between Old Perkins Road and Airline Highway at the parish line. This is a Robert Trent Jones state-of-the-art 18-hole golf course with a two-story clubhouse. The course is on par with many country clubs. Santa Maria has consistently received Golf Digest's highest ranking for a municipal course. The course is built on 150 acres of rolling terrain, featuring 12 lakes and two natural waterways. Sand and grass bunkers, exquisite Bermuda fairways and ancient oaks provide the perfect setting for a memorable test of golf. The 18-hole course measures 7,051 yards in length from the championship tees. The Spanish-style clubhouse includes a pro shop, a full-service restaurant and a private conference/dining room and a fitness center. The restaurant and veranda overlook the beautiful 18th green.

**Club Storage:** Santa Maria Golf Club will provide Club storage during the tournament.

**TOURNAMENT:** The tournament will be a 36-hole stroke play event to be held Friday and Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008. There are three divisions: Senior (50-59), Super Senior (60-69) & Super/Super Senior (70+). Seniors and Super Seniors will play from the Blue Tees (6200 yds) Super/Super Seniors - White Tees (5900 yds) & Ladies – Red Tees (5,600 yds). In the event of a tie for the Championship of the stroke play event; there will be a sudden death playoff. All other ties will use a card-off beginning with the # 1 handicap hole.

In addition an optional Pro-Amp event will be played on Thursday, March 13, 2008.

**ELIGIBILITY:** NAGA members age 50 and older. The field will be limited to the first 120 golfers. Current NAGA membership is required for participation in the tournament. If necessary, include your 2008 NAGA dues with your official tournament application, and check the appropriate box.

**Entry Deadline: January 31, 2006**

**LATE ENTRIES:** Tournament Entry Applications received after the entry deadline of January 31, 2008 will be placed on a waiting list if necessary. Players will be accommodated on a first come-first served basis as openings become available. Players may or may not receive a tournament shirt in the size requested. Confirmation of entry will be made by email.

**Refund Policy:** As noted in the 2007 newsletter, there will be no full refund of fees after February 15, 2008. Should a cancellation of entry, and request for refund become necessary, a written request including the reason for the request should be mailed to the NAGA office at: 11 Walnut Hill Road, Amherst, NH 03031

**PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Practice rounds are available Wednesday, March 13, 2008 on a first-come, first served basis cart fees apply. You are required to make your own tee-times **beginning Monday, March 3, 2008** direct with Santa Maria Golf Club Pro Shop at (225) 752-9667. You must identify yourself as a member of NAGA.

**DRESS CODE:** “Our dress code is designed to maintain an atmosphere consistent with the traditions of golf.” **Men** are required to wear golf shirts with collars, and sleeves and either slacks or shorts of appropriate length. **Women’s** shorts, or golf skirts are to be of appropriate length. Slacks, culottes, Bermuda shorts, golf shirts, or sleeveless tops are permitted.

Santa Maria Golf is a soft spike only club.

# General Information

**Hotel Accommodations:** The tournament host hotel is the Marriott Courtyard, located at 10333 North Mall Rd, Baton Rouge, La. The direct phone number is (225) 293-7200. The hotel is conveniently located just off Interstate 10 at Exit 163 at Siegen Lane Road, 5 miles north of Santa Maria Golf Club, and 3 miles south of downtown Baton Rouge. Rooms have been secured at a rate of \$ 99.00 per night, tax free. You must make reservations direct with the hotel PRIOR TO February 27, 2008, and mention that you are a NAGA tournament participant to receive the preferred rate. Other hotels in this vicinity include Residence Inn by Marriott.

**Car Rental:** NAGA has secured special, discounted rental rates with Hertz. To book your reservation, call (800) 654-2200. Be sure to use Hertz CDP # 1579777 and PC # 961612.

**Ground Transportation:** No shuttle service is provided by the Marriott Courtyard hotel. Taxi service is available from the Baton Rouge Airport to the hotel.

2. Get on Jackie Cochran Dr and drive north
3. Turn left onto Veterans Memorial Blvd
4. Turn right onto Harding Blvd
5. Take right ramp onto I-110 S
6. Keep left onto I-10 E ramp
7. Take exit 159 onto I-10 E
8. Take exit 163 to the right onto Siegen Ln
9. Keep right onto Siegen Ln ramp

### Hotel to Santa Maria Golf Club

#### Approximately 5 ¼ miles

1. Marriott Courtyard
2. Get on N Mall Dr and drive west
3. Keep right onto Siegen Ln
4. Turn right onto I-10 E ramp
5. Take exit 166 to the right
6. Turn left onto Highland Rd
7. Turn right onto Perkins Rd

## Check and Credit Card Payments

As a service to our members, payment of dues and entry fees for tournaments is available by personal check and credit card. The average charge to NAGA for credit card charges is 6%. In recent years, returned checks and denial of payment on credit card charges have become more pronounced and much time is being expended to resolve the issue.

Beginning January 1, 2003, the following policy will apply to any payment to NAGA for dues, entry fees or miscellaneous charges for returned checks or denial of payment on credit card remittances.

A letter or e-mail will be sent to notify the payer that the check or credit card charge has been denied. The notification will specify that the amount due must be paid by certified check or money order (in U. S. funds) to satisfy the obligation. If a payment is rejected for a tournament entry fee, the entry will be denied until the obligation is paid. The member will be laced in "non-member status" until all obligations are satisfied, including a fee of \$ 25.00 U.S. added to all applicable charges of rejected check/credit card.

Should the NAGA member fail to rectify within thirty (30) days of notification, a new application for membership and the appropriate fees will have to be made for reinstatement.

**Denial of Entry** means that the entry to the event is not accepted. In the case where entries are limited by player spot availability, it could result in not participating in the event.
