NAGA Senior National Championship Tournament Information

GOLF COURSE: Carved from the banks of the Cumberland River, Gaylord Springs has earned its place among the nation's best. Designed by former U.S. Open and PGA champion Larry Nelson, the Scottish links-style, par 72 layout offers 18 challenging holes bordered by scenic limestone bluffs. At the signature fourth hole, you'll find the century-old springhouse from which the club derived its name.

TOURNAMENT: The tournament will be a 36-hole stroke play event to correspond with the national Championship. There are three divisions: Senior (50-59), Super Senior (60-69) & Super/Super Senior (70+).

ELIGIBILITY: NAGA members age 50 and older. The field will be limited to the first 120 golfers combined for National and Senior National events. Current NAGA membership is required for participation in the tournament. If necessary, include your 2010 NAGA dues with your official tournament application, and check the appropriate box. **Entry Deadline: August 7th, 2010.**

PARTICIPATING IN BOTH CHAMPIONSHIPS: For those that want to compete in both the National and Senior National Events, the difference in the entry fee is all that will have to be paid. The entry fee difference is \$50 and please mark on the entry form below that you would like to participate in both. Please also be sure to include your guest fee for both awards banquets.

NOTE: Those wishing to compete in both the Senior National and National events will have to play from the National Events Championship tees.

GOLF HANDICAP: There will be a Net Champion at the National Senior Championship in 2010. There will be only one award and the winner may come from any Amputee Division. Only those who have a current valid golf handicap either from the USGA/R&A or a locally recognized organization will be considered and will be verified prior to the competition. **Please fill in the information on your entry form as to your handicap index number and an email/phone number where it can be verified.**

EARLY ENTRIES: Any entry form sent in prior to February 28th can be sent in for a special discounted rate of **\$150**. Any entry forms sent in after this date will need to be sent in at the normal rate of **\$200**. Please see next section for late entries.

LATE ENTRIES: Tournament Entry Applications received after the entry deadline of August 7th, 2010 will be accommodated on a first come-first served basis. Late entrants may or may not receive a tournament golf shirt in the size requested. ***All entries will be confirmed by email.***

REFUND POLICY: No full refund of fees will be made after August 7th, 2010. Should a cancellation of entry, and request for refund become necessary, a written request including the reason for the request should be emailed/mailed to the NAGA office at: 11 Walnut Hill Road, Amherst, NH 03031 for consideration of the request.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds are available Monday, September 6th, 2010. Tee times have been blocked from 9:30am – 12:00 pm. Special green/cart fees apply...\$55.00. You are required to make your own tee-times directly with the Gaylord Springs Pro Shop at **(615) 458-1730** and press extension one. Identify yourself as a member of NAGA.

DRESS CODE: “Our dress code is designed to maintain an atmosphere consistent with the traditions of golf.” **Men** are required to wear golf shirts with collars, and sleeves and either slacks or shorts of appropriate length. **Women’s** shorts or golf skirts are to be of appropriate length. Slacks, culottes, Bermuda shorts, golf shirts, or sleeveless tops are permitted.

CLUB STORAGE: Club storage will be provided by Gaylord Springs during the tournament.

Check and Credit Card Payments

As a service to our members, payment of dues and entry fees for tournaments is available by personal check and credit card. The average charge to NAGA for credit card charges is 6%. In recent years, returned checks and denial of payment on credit card charges have become more pronounced and much time is being expended to resolve the issue.

Beginning January 1, 2003, the following policy will apply to any payment to NAGA for dues, entry fees or miscellaneous charges for returned checks or denial of payment on credit card remittances.

A letter or e-mail will be sent to notify the payer that the check or credit card charge has been denied. The notification will specify that the amount due must be paid by certified check or money order (in U. S. funds) to satisfy the obligation. If a payment is rejected for a tournament entry fee, the entry will be denied until the obligation is paid. The member will be laced in "non-member status" until all obligations are satisfied, including a fee of \$ 25.00 U.S. added to all applicable charges of rejected check/credit card.

Should the NAGA member fail to rectify within thirty (30) days of notification, a new application for membership and the appropriate fees will have to be made for reinstatement.

Denial of Entry means that the entry to the event is not accepted. In the case where entries are limited by player spot availability, it could result in not participating in the event.
