GENERAL INFORMATION

MEMBERSHIP TO NATIONAL: Regular Membership is open to any Amputee (as such term is hereinafter defined). "Amputee" shall mean an individual who is physically absent any extremity (hand or foot), or combination of extremities. Such physical characteristic shall be further defined as an amputation or congenital defect at a major joint of the arm or leg, such as ankle, knee or hip; wrist elbow or shoulder.

GOLF COURSE: The tournament will be played at Sycuan Resort. Singing Hills has changed ownership and is heretofore known as Sycuan Resort. The Golf Club has two 18-hole courses, the Willow and Oak. April 7, Thursday will be at the Willow, Friday will be at the Oak course. Further information regarding the golf course can be obtained the internet: http://www.sycuan.com/sycuan_resort/index.html.

TOURNAMENT: This tournament is open to all amputees 50 years of age and older. The competition will be divided into age groups as follows: Senior Division 50-59; Super Senior division 60-69; Super Super Senior division 70 and older. In the event of a tie for the low gross champion, there will be a sudden death playoff. All other ties will use a card-off system, starting with the number one handicap hole.

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are mailed to all **NAGA** members 50 and older, including life and international members who have paid dues in the current year (2005) or have paid dues in 2003 or 2004. The field will be limited to the first 70 players *with consideration given first to those members who are current with their 2005 NAGA dues.* Current membership; is required to compete. If you are not current with your 2005 NAGA dues, please include your dues with your tournament fees and mark the appropriate box on the official entry form. Mail by March 6, 2005.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds are available Wednesday on a first come, first served basis. The cost will be \$25 with cart. Players should call the golf course to make their own tee times beginning March 25 by calling 800 457-5568. Tell them you are with the National Amputee Golf Association.

NON-GOLFER ACTIVITIES: Activities for non-golfers will be determined by your indications on the entry form in this mailing. More information will be mailed with your confirmation letter.

DRESS CODE: Please wear appropriate golf attire. The dress code is intended to maintain an atmosphere consistent with the tradition of golfing.

Check and Credit Card Payments

As a service to our members, payment of dues and entry fees for tournaments is available by personal check and credit card. The average charge to NAGA for credit card charges is 6%. In recent years, bounced checks and denial of payment on credit card charges has become evident and much time and effort is being expended to resolve the discrepancies.

Beginning January 1, 2003, the following policy will apply to any payment to NAGA for dues, entry fees or miscellaneous charges where checks bounce or credit is denied on charge cards:

Bounced checks/denial of credit card charges:

A letter or email will be sent to notify the payer that the check or credit card charge has been denied by our bank. The notification will specify that the amount due must subsequently be paid by certified check or money order (in US funds) to satisfy the debt. If the payment rejected is for a tournament entry fee, the entry will be denied until the debt is paid and the member will be placed in a "non-member status" until the debt is cleared. **A fee of \$25.00 US will be added to all applicable charges of rejected check/credit.**

Should the Regular or Life Member whose payment by credit card or check is rejected is not rectified within 30 days of notification, a new application for membership and the fee for Life or Regular Membership will have to be made for reinstatement.

Denial of entry:

This simply means the entry was not accepted. In the case where entries are limited by playing spots available, it could result in not playing in the event.

TRANSPORTATION AND LODGING

TRANSPORTATION: The San Diego Airport is approximately 30 minutes to the Sycuan Resort. The Resort provides airport pick-up for \$15 per person each way, 48 hour advance request, call 800-457-5568.

CAR RENTAL: Special rates have been secured with Hertz Rent a Car. Make your reservations on line at www.hertz.com using our CDP# 1579777 and PC# 961612 Or, call 1-800-654-2200 in the U.S, or in Canada call 1-800-263-0600 (in Toronto call 416-620-0620).

TRAVEL INFO: Fly into the San Diego International airport, approximately 30 miles from Sycuan Resort. There is a mandatory registration/reception Wednesday, April 6 at the Sycuan Resort at 5 pm. On Friday, the awards banquet will be over at approximately 7pm.

LOCATION: Sycuan Resort is located about 30 miles from the San Diego airport. Exit Airport to N. Harbor Dr, take I-5 south to Hwy 94 east, continue about 9 miles to 125 north towards La Mesa. Go 2 miles; take I-8 east to El Cajon Blvd exit. Go ½ mile, turn right on W. Washington Ave. Continue about 5 miles, Washington Ave. becomes Dehesa Rd.

ACCOMODATIONS: Sycuan Resort has wonderful resort accommodations on site. They have reserved 35 rooms for our guests. The room rate for dbl is \$125/day weekdays and \$158 Fri-Sat. These rates are about half of regular rate. Call 800 457-5568, tell them you are with the National Amputee Golf Association, **group 327172**. You MUST reserve your room by March 6, or they will be released back to the resort for other guests. Other hotels available, cost based on internet advertised rates:
