GENERAL INFORMATION

MEMBERSHIP TO NATIONAL: Regular Membership is open to any Amputee (as such term is hereinafter defined). "Amputee" shall mean an individual who is physically absent any extremity (hand or foot), or combination of extremities. Such physical characteristic shall be further defined as an amputation or congenital defect at a major joint of the arm or leg, such as ankle, knee or hip, wrist, elbow or shoulder.

GOLF COURSE: Located only 20 minutes from downtown Baton Rouge off of Hwy. 61 in Zachary, BREC's Beaver Creek Golf Club is an outstanding public golf facility designed by Craig Schreiner and Associates. On the plains of northern East Baton Rouge Parish, Beaver Creek features a windswept front nine and a sheltered back nine that meanders through protected wetland areas. The par 72 layout will provide golfers with many unique shot making opportunities.

TOURNAMENT: This tournament is open to amputees 50 years of age and older. The Stroke competition will be divided into age groups as follows: Senior Division 50-59; Super Senior division 60-69; Super/Super Senior division 70 and older and Ladies. A minimum of six players will be needed to constitute a Division. Flights within Divisions will be made depending on number of entries/Division. Play for the Senior & Super Senior will be from the Blue Tees, Super/Super Seniors and Ladies will be from the Red tees. Tee times will be consecutive beginning at Hole #1. In the event of a tie for the low gross champion, there will be a sudden death playoff. All other ties will be broken using the USGA procedures.

ELIGIBILITY: Entries are mailed to all **NAGA** members 50 and older, including life and international members who have paid dues in the current year (2006) or have paid dues in 2005. The field will be limited to the first 120 players with priority given first to those members who are current with their 2006 NAGA dues. Current membership is required to compete. If you are not current with your 2006 NAGA dues, include your dues with your tournament fees and mark the appropriate box on the official entry form. **Mail not later than March 1, 2006.**

REFUND POLICY: As noted in the 2005 Newsletter, there will be no full refunds of fees after March 7, 2006. Should a request for a refund be made, it must be in writing and state the reason (s) for the refund. Requests are to be sent to Bob Wilson, tournament chairman, at the NAGA office.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds are available starting Wednesday, April 5th on a first come basis. The cost will be \$15 PER player including guests, and includes cart with GPS. Players should call the ProShop @ 225-658-6338 to make their own tee times **beginning March 29**. Indicate you are with the National Amputee Golf Association Senior Championship.

GUEST GOLF: Tee times for golfing guests on Saturday and Sunday are available. Individuals will be paired through the ProShop and tee times will immediately follow the last tournament foursome.

DRESS CODE: The dress code is intended to maintain an atmosphere consistent with the tradition of golfing. Men are required to wear golf shirts with collars and sleeves and either golf slacks or shorts of appropriate length (minimum inseam of 7½ in.). No denim of any color is allowed. Women's shorts or golf skirts are to be of appropriate length. Golf slacks, culottes, Bermuda shorts and sleeveless tops are permitted. No denim of any color is allowed. "Not acceptable" golf attire includes: short shorts, tennis shorts, cut-offs, gym shorts, sweats, jeans/denims, tank tops or halter-tops. Coat and tie for the awards banquet is optional.
