Once again, the annual National Senior Championship returns to Louisiana. We are pleased to invite you to Beaver Creek Golf Club, at Zachary, a short drive north of Baton Rouge. The Beaver Creek course should provide a fair test for all competitors.

Thanks to the tremendous support of Carl Johnson, PGA and assistant director of golf for BREC, a Pro/Amputee tournament will be held on Thursday April 6<sup>th</sup>. Carl has insured us that there will be a Pro for each foursome and two guests can join you for this fun event. For those of you who enjoy crawfish, AKA mudbugs, there will be plenty available at the crawfish boil/awards presentation following golf.

The format for the event will be the same as in the past with four divisions...Senior, Super Senior, Super-Super Senior and Ladies. A minimum of six players is needed to form a division. Flights will be established within divisions depending on the number of entrants.

A quick note on lodging: The Hilton Garden Inn, because of its proximity to the Baton Rouge airport, has 130 rooms available and they can fill up quickly. To secure a room, it is imperative that you make your reservation not later than March 1. We have designated the Hilton as the host hotel because of its amenities and proximity to Beaver Creek. There are other accommodations available in the area, however travel time and distance to the course will be lengthened.

We ask that you please register early and not later than March 1. Numbers become critical in the planning for food functions and the ordering of golf shirts. The field is limited to the first 120 who return their entry with appropriate fees.
